Handcrafts Prosper Galore at Window Shoppe

Have you ever walked down the hallway in the University Village Clubhouse? If not, you haven't seen the beautiful display of knitted and other handmade articles by Needle Crafters.

Founded in 2008, soon after University Village was opened, Needle Crafters started out with 14 members. Under the leadership of Alice Sage and Marty Mortensen, Needle Crafters welcomed any resident who appreciated handcrafts.

The creative organization brought in members who enjoyed knitting, needlework, embroidery, cross-stitch, needlepoint, crochet and quilting. The items they produced were sold at the Window Shoppe with most proceeds going to the Employee Appreciation Fund (EAF). The Window Shoppe, located across from the hallway computer room, was actually founded by Needle Crafters so that members would have a place to display and sell their wares.

Two other original members of Needle Crafters, Marian Shull and Claire Drewes, have knitted many items for the group often with yarn supplied by Marty. Members are asked to knit squares of their own design.

When completed, the squares are given to Marty, who once she has 36 squares, sews them together to make blankets and washes each item before putting it on display.

The role of Needle Crafters has expanded through the years. The group had a number of projects including two to three boutiques each year, knitting scarves for servicemen in Afghanistan

and making chemo caps for cancer patients. Under Alice and Marty the Window Shoppe and the Needle Crafters donated over \$59,000 to the EAF. After Alice's departure in 2018, the Shoppe has been operating under the excellent leadership of Donna Keister. In 2011 because of her creative involvement in Needle Crafters, Marian began designing and creating jewelry with proceeds from sales also going to the EAF.

COVID-19 put a stop to meetings throughout campus in March, but members of Needle Crafters are still knitting even though they are not meeting. Caps, scarves, and blanket squares are the most common items produced. Anyone who has needlecraft interest is welcome to join the group. Simply call Marty at
