Patt's airline employer enabled them to vacation throughout the world during their initial years of marriage. The first of their two boys was born in 1969 and Patt retired to raise the family. After working for several companies in technical sales positions, Stan decided to embark upon his long-held desire to start his own company. The opportunity came in 1978 when he negotiated with his then employer to buy a tiny and neglected piece of their operation. What he purchased was only a file cabinet of engineering drawings and a letter of introduction to the few airline customers that remained. Since the business involved repair of

aircraft parts, the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) required certification which was not easy for a oneman operation.



Fortunately, a church friend invited him to share a small area of his machine shop and this provided the appearance the FAA needed. The new company, Repairtech, was formed and at age 39, Stan became self-employed—frightening!

Without a weekly paycheck, he took a second deed on their house, put his wife back to work at UCLA and began the arduous task of bringing this miniscule entity to life. Long hours ensued and having two young boys at home also placed demands on his time.

Patt pitched in and provided the needed balance their family needed. She helped with the new company when she could. As time went on, the business began to gain strength. A Van Nuys building was purchased and people were hired. It has now been 42 years since the company was founded. Their younger son, who is also an engineer, has taken over the company and it has flourished under his leadership. Though the pandemic prohibits Stan from going into the Van Nuys office, he continues to work from home.
