

Dream Flights, formerly known as Ageless Aviation, planned Operation September Freedom (OSF) this year, a national effort to honor as many World War II veterans as possible with free Dream Flights in restored, open-cockpit Stearman biplanes. During this 45-minute Dream Flight, our veterans experienced the freedom and exhilaration of soaring 1,000 feet in the air in an iconic Stearman biplane, the same aircraft used to train aviators during WWII.

Once the OSF announcement was made, the Activities Department went to work to make this special opportunity available to UVTO's WWII veterans. On September 27, four of these honorable Americans made the trip to Camarillo Airport to participate in the Dream Flight. Our flyers were Chuck Ullman, Joe Vana, George Hanks, and Gene Smith. Our Dream Flight pilot and crew chief were Mike and Lynn Sommars. Mike is a retired American Airlines captain with an incredible amount of aviation experience and Lynn is a nurse in the senior care industry. Together they are known as the Sommars Team, and they did an excellent job with our veterans.
