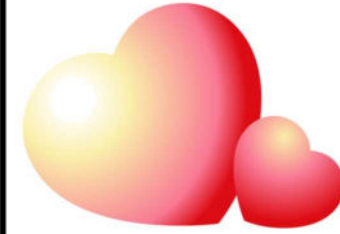

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Resident Government at University Village

We who live at University Village Thousand Oaks participate in self-government with zest and enthusiasm, through Resident Council and eight standing committees. These groups are established in the Resident Association Bylaws and reconstituted each January following elections and appointments at the end of the previous year. Their effectiveness depends, in large part, on various opportunities for interaction with UVTO’s management and owners.



The one elected body is Resident Council, with nine members selected at large to serve for three years. Meetings, on the Monday before Town Hall, include working communication with our Executive Director. Residents’ voices are welcome, so attend, listen and speak up. Please communicate with the 2023 Chairperson if you have an agenda item.

A second representative group is Building Representatives, convened by the Resident Council Vice Chair. Nineteen members represent each floor of the four “View” buildings (12), the Garden Terraces (3) and the Villas (4). Each Representative has an Alternate; all may participate in the monthly meetings, interacting with Plant Operations, Housekeeping (EVS), and Safety Directors, as well as the Executive Director.



Eight standing committees address a wide variety of resident interests, needs and experiences: Activities, Bereavement, Budget and Finance, Food and Beverage, Health and Wellness, Hospitality, Library, Safety and Security. Committee members serve for three year terms, most meet monthly, and the committees select new members to fill openings at the beginning of each year and as vacancies occur during the year. Residents are welcome to observe; as a courtesy, those with a matter to bring to a committee should contact the Chair in advance.

Communication connected to resident government (and more!) happens in many ways. Resident Association meetings provide opportunities to interact with UVTO owners and the Trustee, and to hear from candidates seeking election to the Council. Each Resident Council member provides two-way liaison with a committee. UVTO Directors work with appropriate committees, usually attending the meetings and helping facilitate follow-up as needed. Town Hall meetings are held monthly to keep residents informed on current matters. So, offer your leadership skills – and, above all, participate!
