## Pickleball/Tennis Players Celebrate New Courts

Thanks to swift action by UVTO Management, pickleball and tennis players were able to celebrate the repaved and re-striped court in late April. To mark the occasion, UVTO Management sponsored an Opening Ceremony on April 24, complete with food and beverage, and a ribbon cutting.

About six months ago, the Pickleball players began to lobby for more courts as the number of players continues to grow at a linear pace to reach 20 players. The principal proposal was to remark the courts to accommodate four pickleball courts on the single tennis court. When the heavy rains began to eat into the playing surface it became imperative to repave the court as soon as possible. With the leadership of Plant Operations Director Bill Evans and the approval of Managing Partner Bob Bouchard, bids were sought.

The players thought this to be the opportune time to remark the courts for four instead of two. At first, there was opposition from management and some players. Finally, after extensive research and measurements at the court, a summit meeting was held on the court along with management and the paving contractor who has paved many courts. Players held a trial play with chalk marks to try the new layout. After that, a consensus was reached that four courts were the way to go. The work was completed in ten days, leading to the opening ceremony.

At the ceremony, Executive Director Dmitry Estrin thanked all who brought this project to a successful conclusion in record time. He cited this as an outstanding example of management and residents working together.
